### Bridge Closure – Use 8<sup>th</sup> Street Detour

Beginning at 6 p.m. on Thursday, Sept. 12 the 27<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge, S. Grand Ave. intersection, Atkinson Trail and the Roaring Fork River will close and remain closed through the weekend. Crews will be working through the night all weekend. Expect heavy construction machinery and large lights at night. The new bridge is expected to open to traffic at 6 a.m. on Mon., Sept. 16. This is weather dependent.

The 27<sup>th</sup> Street traffic detour will be via 8th Street during the closure period. *See detour map below.* There will be no through access at S. Grand Ave. and 27<sup>th</sup> Street (Buffalo Valley is not an alternate route for CO 82). Significant traffic delays are anticipated, so plan ahead. The pedestrian and bicyclist detours for 27<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge and Atkinson Trail are via the Old Cardiff Bridge or via the 14<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge. Local business and residential access will remain open with detours.

### River Access

During the closure, there is no through river access at 27<sup>th</sup> Street. All river users must eddy-out at or before 3-Mile Creek or put-in downstream of the 27<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge. This safety closure is critical for overhead work. Call before you float to hear the latest river status, 618-5379.

### Pedestrian Access – Use 14<sup>th</sup> Street Detour or Cardiff Bridge

During this closure, there will be no pedestrian access at 27<sup>th</sup> Street. While the new pedestrian bridge is anticipated to be completed prior to the slide, there will be critical infrastructure being ran temporarily across the bridge and it is vital to the project to keep this area secure and safe. The pedestrian bridge will not be open to public viewing because of the proximity to the existing bridge and potential hazards to pedestrians. There will be no pedestrian access through the work area at any time.
