CITY OF GLENWOOD SPRINGS AND ROARING FORK TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY TO HOST MULTIMODAL OPEN HOUSE

The City of Glenwood Springs and the Roaring Fork Transportation Authority (RFTA) invite the community to an open house to obtain input on priorities and potential locations for a new multimodal facility in Glenwood Springs. The open house will offer the public the opportunity to provide input directly into the Multimodal Facility Study development, thereby contributing towards shaping the future of transportation in the community.

Glenwood Springs' Long Range Transportation Vision calls for an integrated transportation system that moves people and goods, provides modal choices, preserves the quality of life, and promotes economic vitality, while celebrating the small town environment. The multimodal facility would enable the community and visitors to transfer easily between many transportation modes, including bicycles, walking, carpools/vanpools, local buses, regional bus rapid transit buses, passenger rail and commercial bus lines.

The City has contracted with LSC Transportation Consultants of Colorado Springs and Design Workshop of Aspen to develop recommendations for services that would be included in the multimodal facility and to review possible locations. Information gathered at the open house will be utilized in the development of a final list of facility services and location sites.

The open house will be held on Tuesday February 7, 2012. There will be two sessions: the first from noon to 1:30 p.m., and the second from 5:00 to 6:30 p.m. The event will be held at Colorado Mountain College (CMC), 802 Grand Avenue (formerly the US Bank building), Third Floor, in Glenwood Springs.

In addition to the City and RFTA, other working group members include Amtrak, Greyhound Lines and CMC.
